The Ship that we will cruise on is the **ms Westerdam**, Holland America Line **7-Day Alaskan Explorer Via the Hubbard Glacier**.

Please keep in mind that the price, per person, includes <u>ALL</u> meals and room service 24/7 while onboard the ship. The price also includes many shipboard activities to include lectures, shopping, movies, shows, casino, pools and more. The only out of pocket cost is for alcohol, soda and any purchases you make while on shore leave or aboard ship. Additional shore excursions are booked at your own expense. Shore excursion information will be provided at the time of booking, but you may get information on the website or brochure.

You will need a valid PASSPORT for the cruise and if you plan on attending you should start working on the paperwork now.

At this point, if you have and questions regarding the cruise, you can contact Crystal Monday through Friday between the hours of 0800 and 1630.
